1. WHAT IS YOUR FAMILIARITY WITH PUBLIC AGENCY BUDGETING?

I have over 15 years' experience with budgeting responsibility with Humboldt County Department of Public Works overseeing numerous budget units. I also have over 20 years experience in developing and approving project cost estimates.

2. DESCRIBE YOUR EXPERIENCE WITH COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

I have over 20 years of progressive, broad based experience with Humboldt County Department of Public Works. This includes positions within the Engineering Division, the Land Use Division, and the Road Maintenance & Fleet Services Divisions. I have fostered good working relationships with other County Departments and public agencies. I am a team player and a problem solver.

3. WHY ARE YOU INTERESTED IN SERVING ON THE CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MEASURE Z EXPENDITURES?

Measure Z is a sales tax that is to be used *to maintain/improve essential services, such as 24-hour sheriffs patrols; 9-1-1 emergency response; crime investigation/prosecution; drug/illegal marijuana grow house enforcement/prevention; services for abused children/mentally ill; rural fire protection; road repairs; and other County services.* This is the language in the ballot measure that the voters approved. At the time that the Measure Z Citizen Advisory Committee was established, permanent seats were established for a Sheriff Representative and for a Fire Chief Association Representative. A permanent seat was not established for a Public Works Representative, even though road repairs are specifically mentioned on the ballot measure. Having a representative on the advisory committee that is an advocate of road repairs will help balance the voice of the committee.

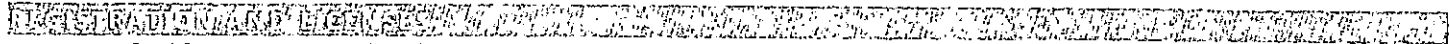

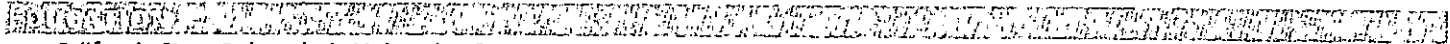

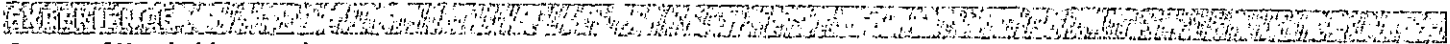

Upon the retirement of the Deputy Director of Road & Equipment Maintenance Division in 2017, I assumed these duties to gain experience in road maintenance. This is in addition to overseeing the Land Use Division as described below. I am responsible for a combined staff of over 100 and 6 budget units. In addition to the duties described below for the Land Use Division, the duties for Road Maintenance includes 6 road maintenance districts, traffic control unit, crusher unit, vegetation maintenance unit, bridge maintenance unit, boat unit, and transportation unit. Equipment maintenance includes fleet services for the entire county and heavy equipment maintenance for the Department.

My position was reclassified from Associate Engineer to Deputy Director. See below for a description of my duties and responsibilities.

County of Humboldt– Eureka, CA **Associate Engineer, 06/2005 to 05/2012**
I promoted to Associate Engineer in the Land Use Division. This position serves as a direct report to the Director of Public Works and is part of the Department's leadership team. Duties include managing the Land Use Division consisting of a staff of 12 and 3 budget units. This Division includes the Land Development Projects Section, Real Property & Right of Way Section, and Survey Section. The Land Development Projects Section is responsible for reviewing projects for impacts to Department maintained infrastructure, establishing subdivision conditions of approval, subdivision inspection, and the Encroachment Permit Office. The Real Property & Right of Way Section is responsible for acquiring right of way for capital improvement projects, maintaining the library of real property records, and leasing County owned facilities. The Survey Section is responsible for all surveying needed for capital improvement projects and includes the County Surveyor. I am responsible for representing the Department before the Planning Commission, Board of Supervisors, and other public meetings. I also serve as Deputy County Surveyor.

County of Humboldt– Eureka, CA **Associate Civil Engineer, 04/2000 to 06/2005**
I was responsible for overseeing the Design Section of the Engineering Division. I supervised a staff of five. My duties included project management and engineering for public works projects. I was responsible for project delivery. My experience included the preparation of plans and specifications to Caltrans standards and processing projects through Caltrans and other agencies, as well as coordination with other divisions for surveying, right of way, and permitting. Projects included street improvement plans, bicycle facilities, pedestrian facilities, storm drains, and airport projects.
