Subject:

Resolution to Increase the Revolving Petty Cash Fund at the Public Works Department

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Adopt Resolution# <u>Iv-ID2</u> to increase the Petty Cash fund at the Public Works Department by \$200; and
- 2. Rescind Resolution#95-112 that was approved by the Board on December 19, 1995 (item D-40).

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Road Fund 1200

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: On December 19, 1995, the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution #95-112 that increased the petty cash fund for the Public Works Road Fund from \$50 to \$200.

Due to the increased volume of transactions and cost of goods and services over the last 20 years, the amount of \$200 is no longer sufficient to cover daily minor out-of-pocket expenditures and requires frequent fund replenishment.

This agenda item requests to increase the existing petty cash fund of \$200 to \$400.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is in need of a revolving fund to finance the expenditure of small sums of cash in the daily operations of the Public Works Department including out-of-pocket expenditures, minor cost items and making change; and

. WHEREAS, Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) is a sufficient sum for such purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of Humboldt hereby establishes a revolving fund in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for use by the Public Works Department in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth above and subject to the provisions of Sections 29320 et seq. of the Government Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk is hereby directed to increase the County's blanket bond to meet the requirements of the Government Code, if necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 80-129, which established a revolving fund in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) is hereby rescinded.
