POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE REZONING LANDS IN THE REDWAY AREA; AMENDING SECTION 311-7 OF CHAPTER 1 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE TO ADD AN INDOOR CULTIVATION Q — QUALIFIED COMBINING ZONE TO SEVEN PACELS, 223-311-010, 223-311-011, 223-311-012, 223-311-043, 223-311-035, 223-311-030, and 223-311-029 IN THE REDWAY BUSINESS PARK.
On Tuesday, March 18, 2024, during its regularly scheduled meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance which amends Humboldt County Code to apply a Q – Qualified Combining Zone to seven parcels in the Redway Business Park. The Q zone allows for indoor commercial cannabis cultivation in the Business Park (MB) zone. The Q zone provides performance standards for indoor commercial cannabis cultivation relating to water usage, energy, and odor. This ordinance amends section 311-7 of Chapter 1 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code.
