

SOURCE OF FUNDING: State of California Employment Development Department

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The Workforce Development Board receives formula funds from the State of California Employment Development annually to provide core program services as required by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). WIOA Adult program services include working with businesses and job seekers to provide training and support which mutually benefits both parties. The amount budgeted for this program for FY 2015-16 was based on an estimate, as the state did not release the grant funding amount until after the county's budget submission deadline. The amount received for WIOA Adult program funds was higher than the estimate, and this budget adjustment increase reflects the actual grant amount and actual costs anticipated to be incurred prior to June 30, 2016.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: The budget adjustment incorporates an increase based solely on grant funding. No funds will be expended beyond the grant allocation amount so there will be no impact on the County's general fund.

This action supports the County's core role of "Supporting business, workforce development and creation of private sector jobs" in your Board's Strategic Framework.

<u>OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT</u>: Department of Health and Human Services – Employment Training Division (DHHS-ETD) is the subcontractor who provides the program services and is paid with these funds.

<u>ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: Your board could choose to not approve this supplemental budget. This alternative is not recommended because it would remove the opportunity to expend all available funding which may result in the state recapturing any unexpended funds.
