

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Table Bluff Road is an existing two lane asphalt road in Humboldt County south of Eureka and north of the town of Loleta. The road generally runs in a north-south orientation. Table Bluff Road going north from Eel River Road, is the main road to and from the project site. It is maintained by Humboldt County.

The general area is very rural/agriculture in nature with large parcel sizes. There are a limited number of homes and farms that access Table Bluff Road. Traffic volumes are estimated at less than 500 ADT near Eel River Road and less than 100 ADT near the project site. The County has a maintenance yard off Table Bluff Road on Hookton Cemetary Road.


