WHEREAS, in June 2005, Lila accepted a full-time CHOW II position which she held until her recent retirement; and

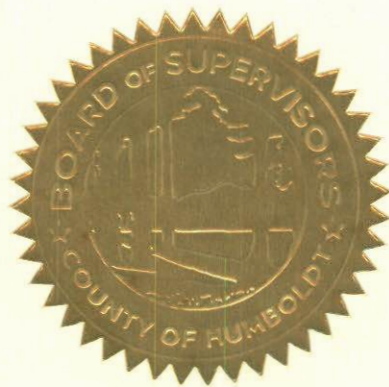
WHEREAS, Lila spent many of her years working in the Eastern Humboldt community where she connected community residents with essential services and resources and fostered relationships between local agencies; and
