Dear Rodney Yandell,

This letter is to address the relocation of the cannabis cultivation site for the landowner of APN 221-021-026. The applicant submitted a 3-acre conversion plan for the previously graded flats, within the plan submitted, Timberland Resources identified a site (completely decommissioned cultivation site on the attached map), that was unsuitable for cultivation. Upon identification Timberland Resources included a restoration plan that my client began executing *before* the wet period set in.

I took this permit over in December 2018, and I have read through these materials. However, the materials do not include a plan to relocate the cannabis canopy area from the remediated area. I have assessed the property with the landowner and would like to recommend a relocation of his cultivation area to the existing cultivation area in the center portion of the parcel near the processing and worker facilities (POU#2). This site is environmentally superior due to its greater distance from watercourses, and easily meets the necessary Streamside Management Area setback requirements.

My client would also like to change the configuration of his cannabis. Historically POU#3 has been a mixed light greenhouse. My client would like to change this area to outdoor and cease all power needed to this cultivation area. He would like then for the entire 10,000 sq. ft. of mixed light canopy to be in the center area in the two greenhouses. This contains the power needed for the area and the power generated will mean my client will be able to achieve the 80% renewable energy requirements that are approaching.

I have advised my client to make no changes until you have approved the requested areas to cultivate in. At this time, it means my client will start the season without a substantial amount of his canopy, pending approval from this request. Please advise when my client can begin the renovation process, which entails specifically building up the two existing greenhouses to a larger size and removing the greenhouse as noted above for outdoor cultivation.

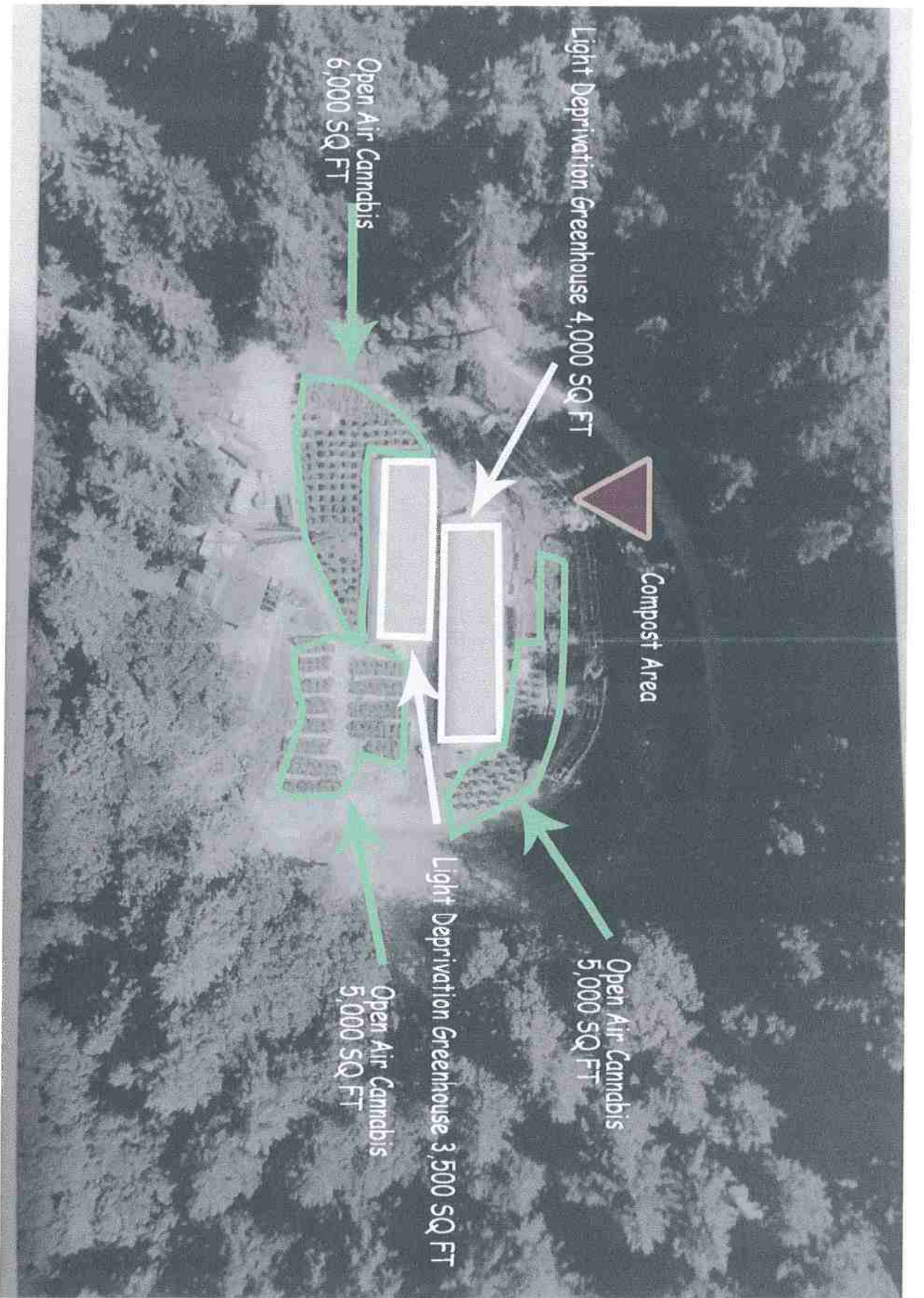

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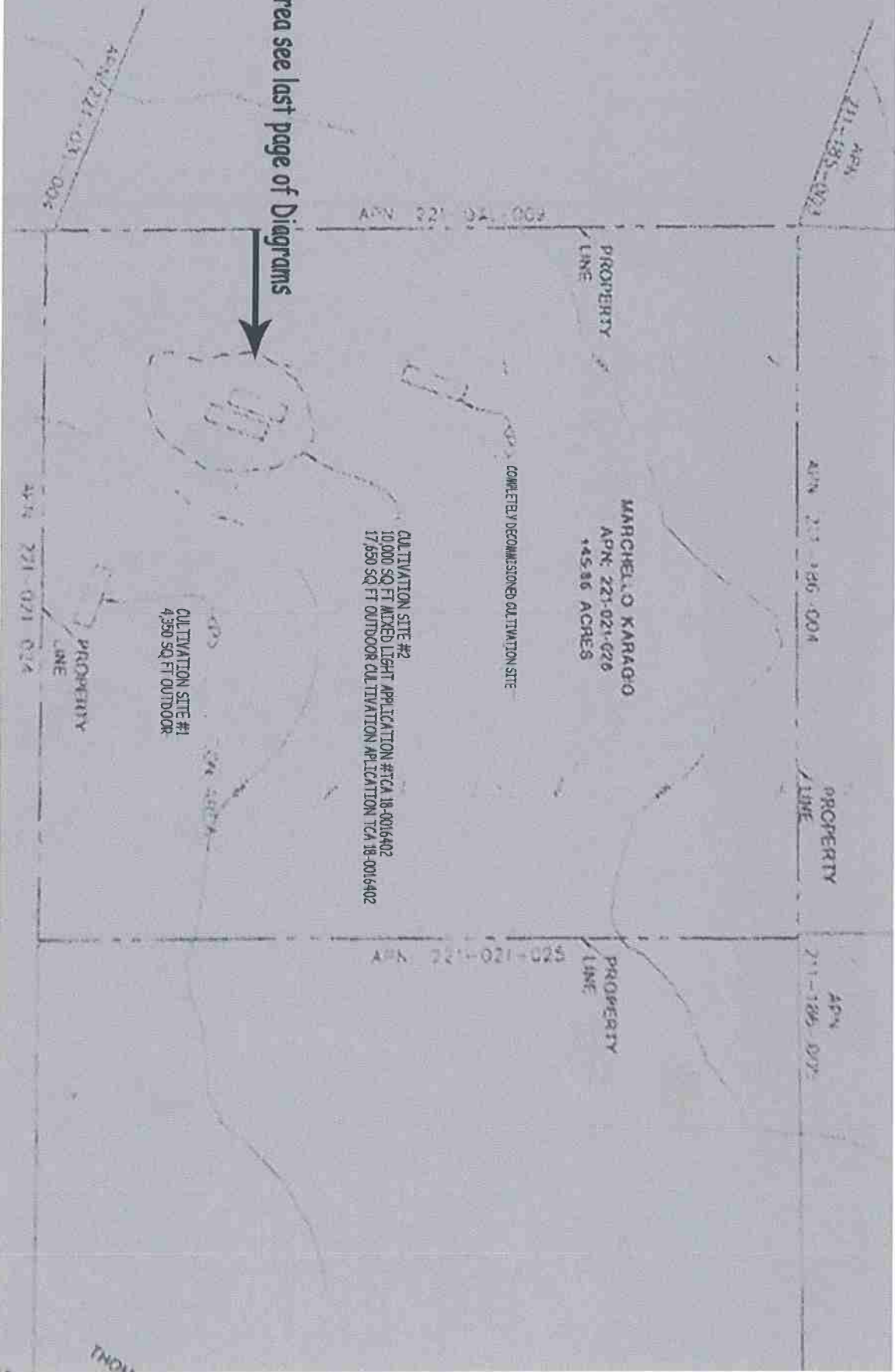

Cultivation Site 1



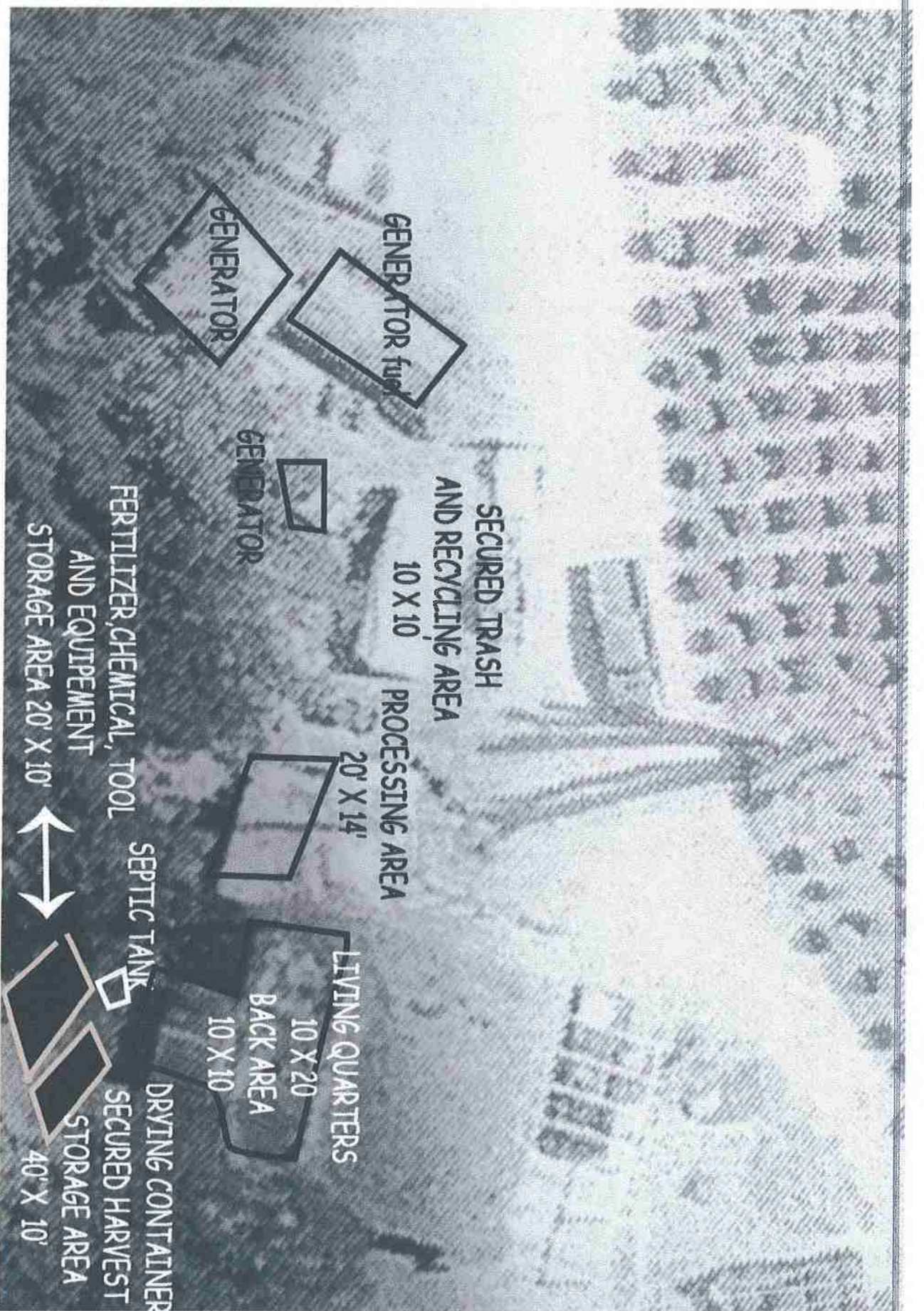

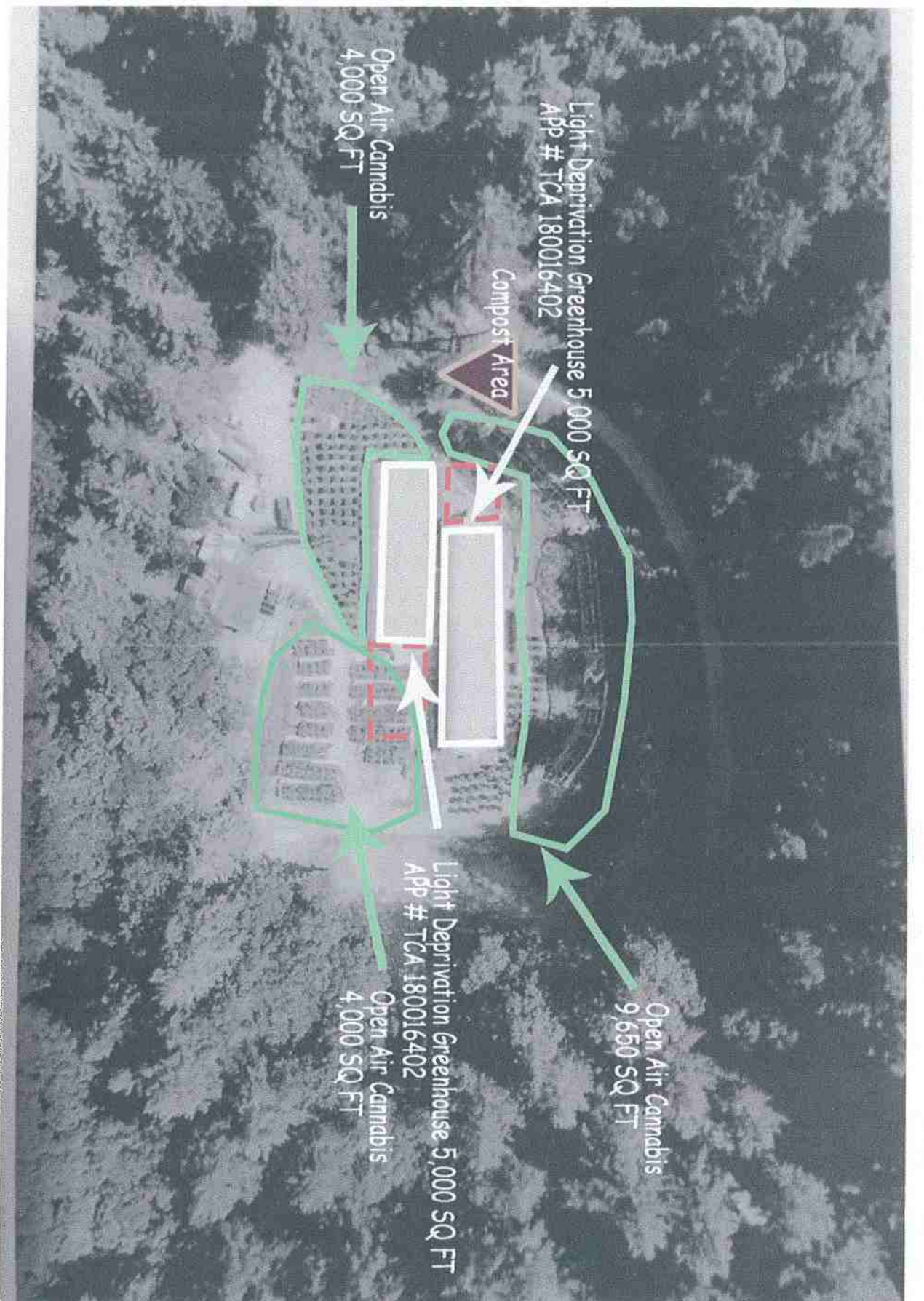
Cultivation Site 1 OUTDOOR ONLY

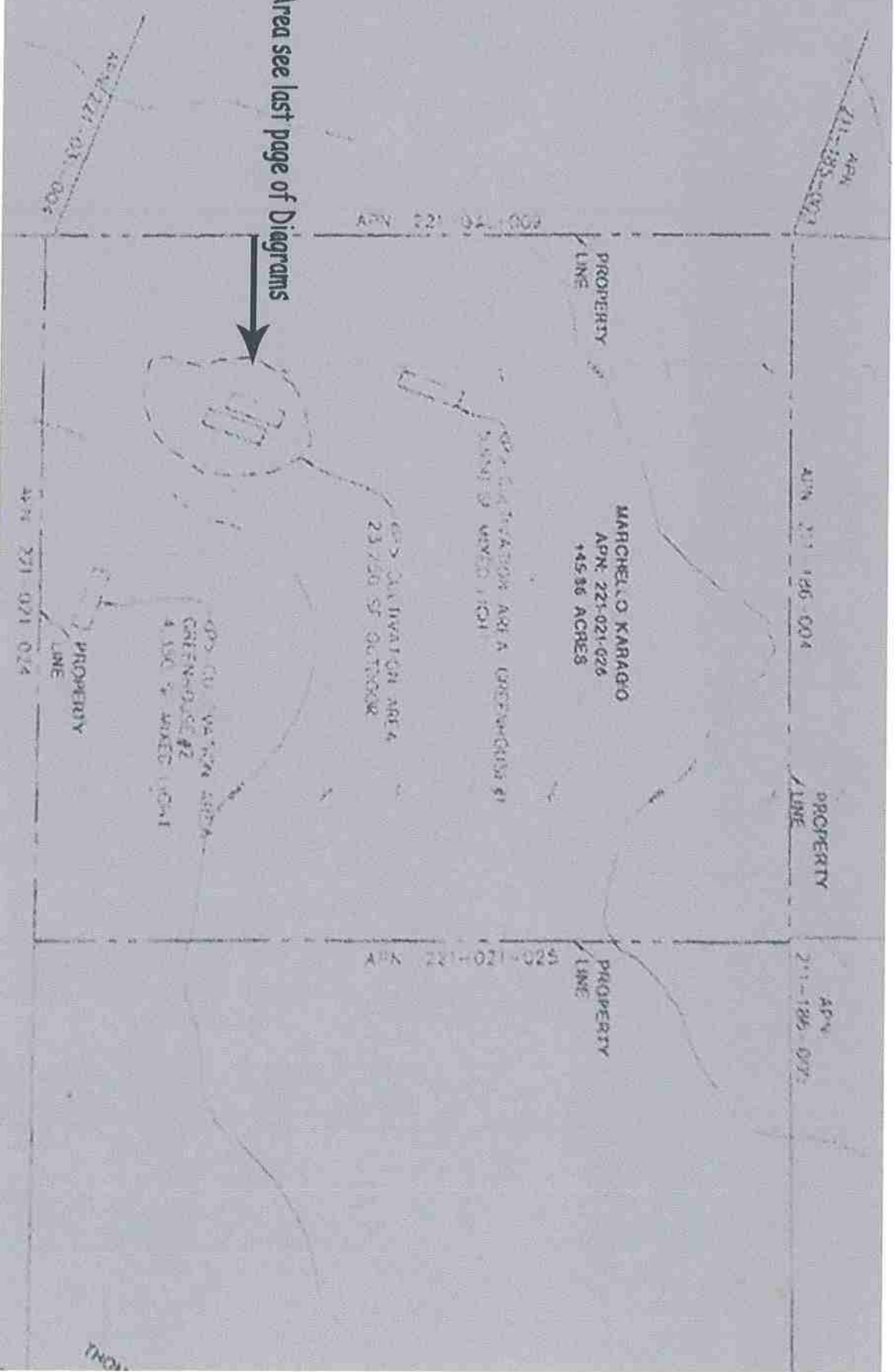
Outdoor Cultivation Area # 2 17,650 SQ FT GREENHOUSES ON DIFFERENT APPLICATION

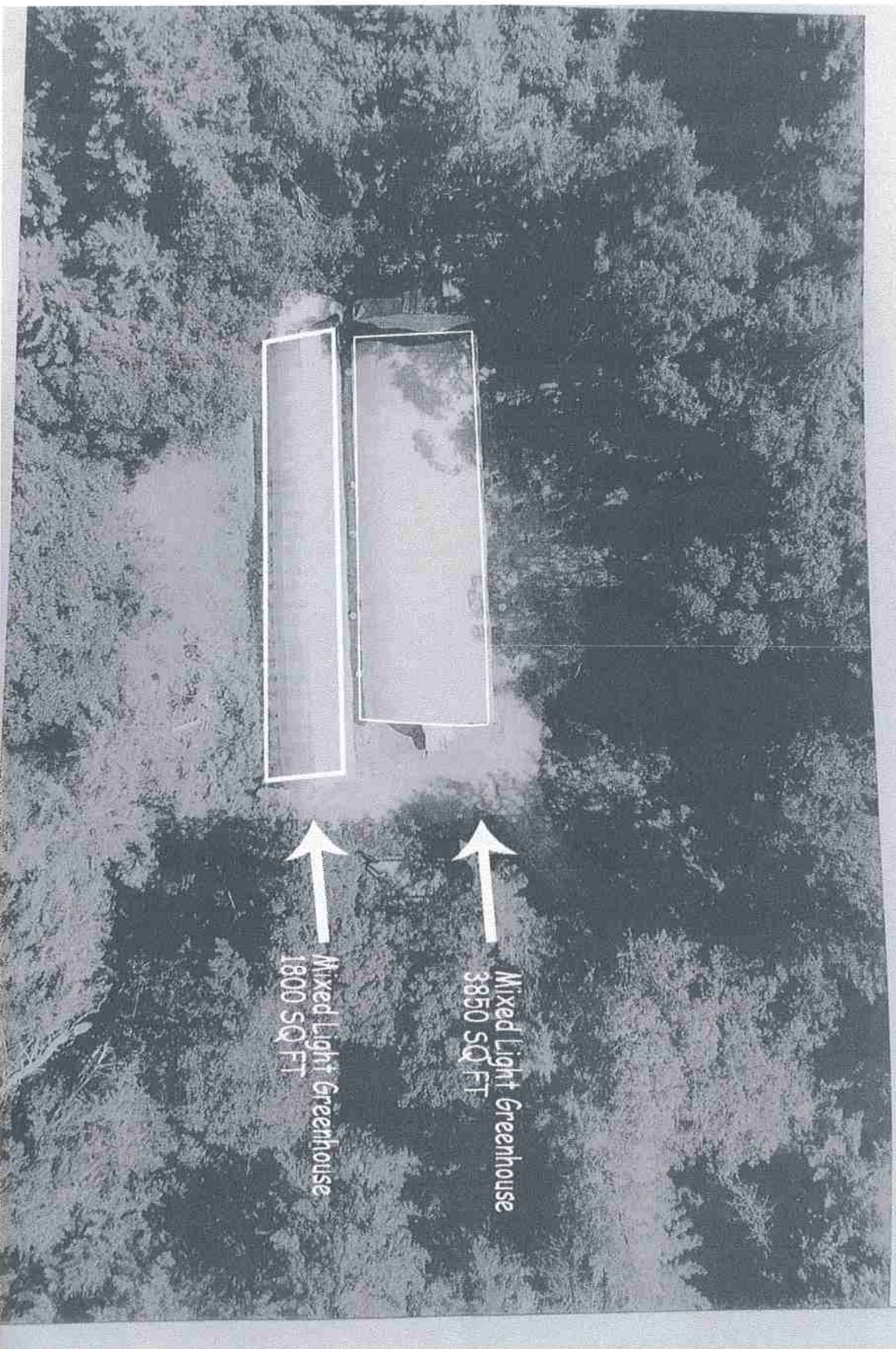
Cultivation Site 1



Cultivation Site 1 Mixed Light Green House 4,350 sq ft

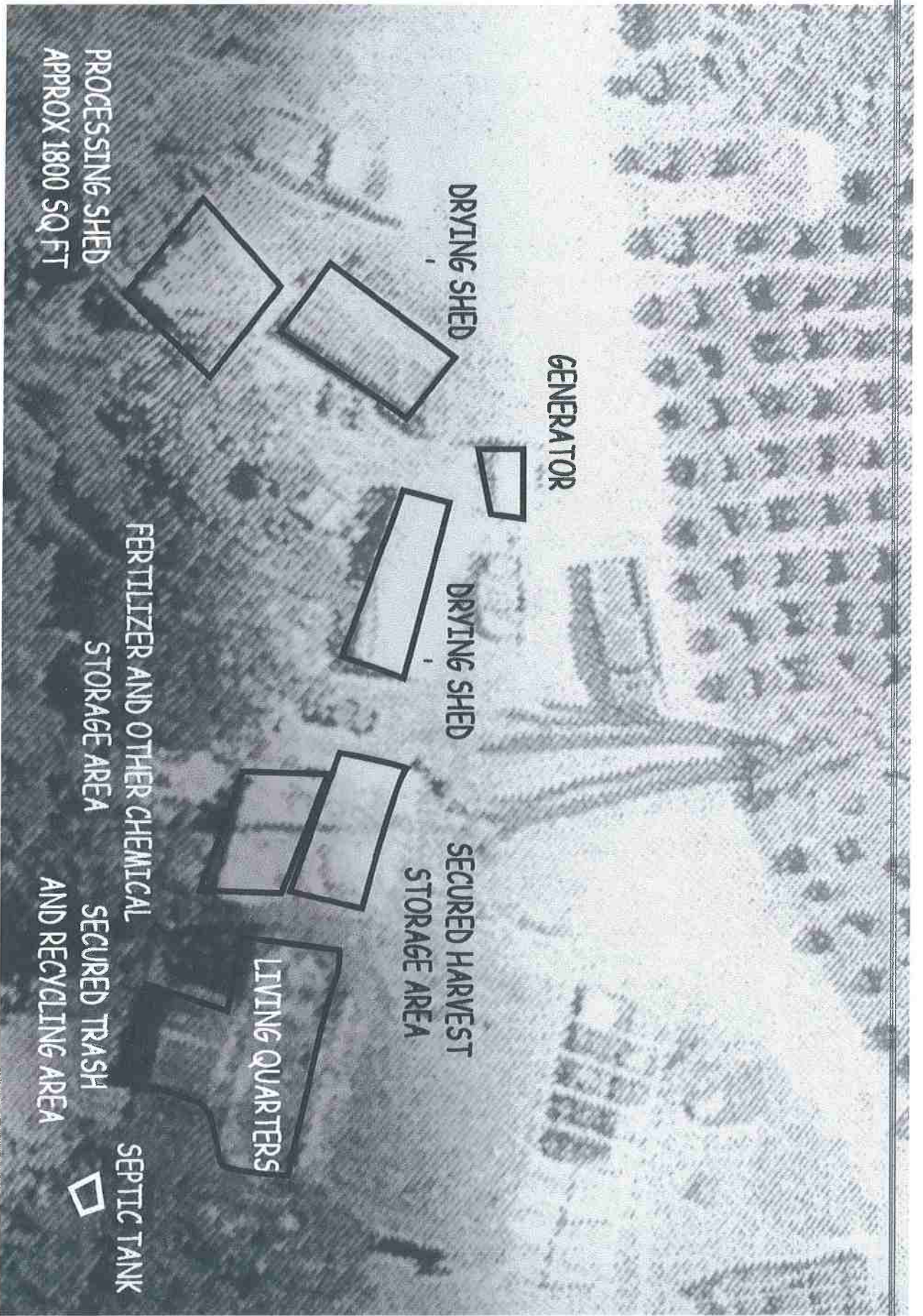
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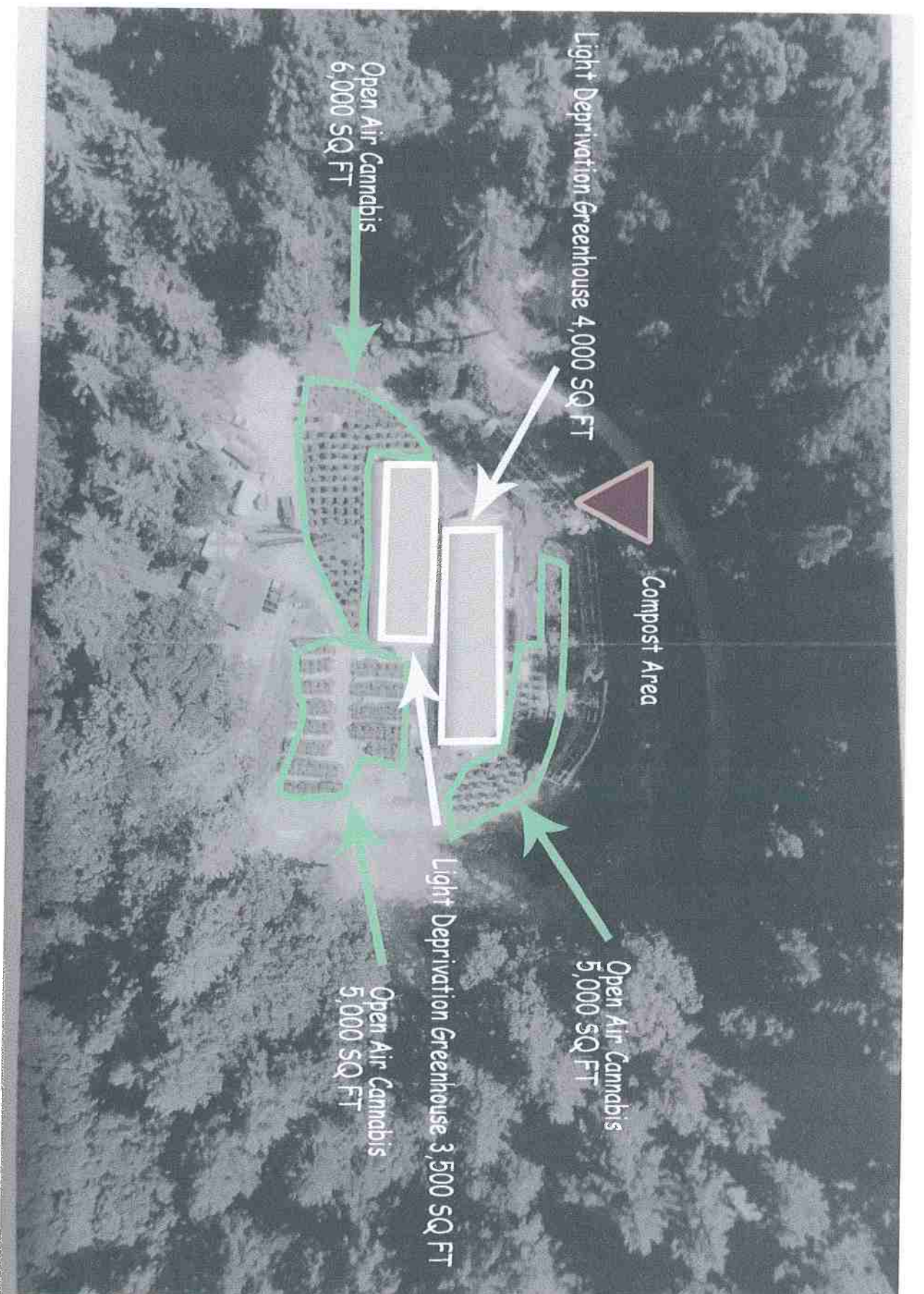
Cultivation Site 2
