EXTEND THE EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY LIST FOR SHERIFF'S LIEUTENANT

## RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors: approve the extension of the employment eligibility list for Sheriff's Lieutenant for one year, to expire on April 10, 2017.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: General Fund, Measure Z

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The Sheriff has requested that the current employment eligibility list for Sheriff's Lieutenant be extended by one year. Humboldt County Merit System Rule IV, 6. states that, "the name of a person on an employment list shall be valid for one year unless the eligibility is extended by the Board of Supervisors."

The Sheriff anticipates potential for promotional opportunities for Sheriff's Lieutenant within the next year. The existing employment eligibility list for Sheriff's Lieutenant is sufficient to meet the anticipated appointment needs of the Sheriff over that time period. As such, Human Resources is requesting that the Board extend the eligibility list by one year, expiring on April 10, 2017.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: There is no immediate financial impact in extending this employment eligibility list. Any financial impact would come as a result of filling vacant positions.

## OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT: None

<u>ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: Your Board could choose to not approve the extension of the employment eligibility list. This would require Human Resources to implement the recruitment process to develop a new employment list.
