

Letter of Support for SB 867 (Roth) Authorizing Counties to Continue to Collect Funds to

Support Local Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Systems

RECOMMENDATION(S): That the Board of Supervisors authorize the Chair to sign the letter of support.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: N/A

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Existing law establishes the Maddy Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Fund, and authorizes each county to establish an emergency medical services fund for reimbursement of costs related to emergency medical services. Existing law, until January 1, 2017, authorizes county boards of supervisors to elect to levy an additional penalty, for deposit into the EMS Fund, in the amount of \$2 for every \$10 upon fines, penalties, and forfeitures collected for criminal offenses. Existing law, until January 1, 2017, requires 15% of the funds collected pursuant to that provision to be used to provide funding for pediatric trauma centers. SB 867 would extend the operative date of these provisions until January 1, 2027.

The Board is being asked to support SB 867 as the bill is critically important in continuing to provide millions of dollars locally and throughout the State to support the Emergency Medical and Health Care Safety Network.

Dear Governor Brown:

On Behalf of the Humboldt County Board of Supervisor, I am writing in full support of SB 867. This bill will continue critically important supplemental "Maddy" Emergency Medical Services funding, as well as Pediatric Trauma Center ("Richie") funding for counties, hospitals, physicians and Local Emergency Medical Services Agencies across California.

The rural North Coast of California does not have a Pediatric Trauma Center within 300 miles. SB 867 will continue direct "Richie" funding to North Coast EMS designated Emergency Departments approved for Pediatrics in Humboldt County. In addition, SB 867 authorizes counties to collect funds to support local Emergency Medical Services systems and pediatric care, as well as hospitals and physicians who provide uncompensated patient care.

Without SB 867 funding, hospitals, physicians, children's specialty care centers and Local Emergency Medical Services Agencies throughout California could face substantial funding cuts and the emergency medical care of adults and children alike will suffer.

Our Board strongly supports SB 867 and respectfully requests your support of this very important legislation.
