

Humboldt County Board of Supervisors PROCLAMATION

recognizing

SEPTEMBER 28, 2025, AS “NATIONAL DAY OF SERVICE”

WHEREAS, the residents of Humboldt County value service, collaboration, and compassion as foundational principles of community life; and

WHEREAS, the National Day of Service unites individuals, civic organizations, and government entities in a shared commitment to address urgent needs and improve the well-being of our communities; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2025, the Eureka Woman’s Club, in partnership with the General Federation of Women’s Clubs, the California Federation of Women’s Clubs, the Jennifer Bushnell Memorial Fund, Humboldt Domestic Violence Services, local law enforcement, tribal representatives, and community advocates, will host a public event raising awareness about domestic violence, missing and murdered Indigenous women, and human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, Humboldt County is dedicated to addressing these critical issues by supporting prevention programs, survivor services, and collaborative solutions that protect the safety, dignity, and human rights of all residents; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the importance of volunteerism and civic engagement in creating lasting change, and encourages citizens to lend their time, talents, and voices to causes that strengthen the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby declares September 28, 2025, as “**National Day of Service**” in the County of Humboldt, and urges all residents to participate in local service opportunities, educational forums, and community initiatives that foster safety, equality, and justice for all.
