RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF THE 401(A) DEFINED CONTRIBUTION PLAN (THE “PLAN”)

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, Humboldt County has maintained the Plan for the benefit of county employees since 2002; and

WHEREAS, all retirement plans must abide by Internal Revenue Service (IRS) guidelines and that all employers must restate their plan documents every 6 years to incorporate legal updates that have occurred during that timeframe; and

WHEREAS, the Plan during the current 6 year restatement cycle process has been determined to no longer meet the IRS updates which have occurred during that timeframe; and

WHEREAS, the Plan cannot reasonably be brought into compliance with IRS requirements and still meet the objectives for which the plan was originally adopted; and

WHEREAS, the last contribution to the Plan was July 23, 2021, prior to the restated Plan Document being published on August 16, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Humboldt County hereby orders that no more employee contributions will be allowed into the Plan and hereby terminates the Plan as of October 26, 2021.
