DISCUSSION:

The Emergency Services division of the Sheriff's Office is responsible for disaster preparedness and Homeland Security coordination within the County, as well as the Humboldt Operational Area. Budget unit 213 was established by the Board of Supervisors in May 2003 specifically for the State Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP). The Board designated the Office of Emergency Services to administer the grant and oversee purchasing of equipment and training for local agencies, including fire, police, and first responders. The Homeland Security Grant is the single revenue source for budget unit 213 of Emergency Services under the Sheriff's Office, and the grant provides 100% reimbursement of allowable expenditures.

This request for budget adjustment will enable the HSGP to expend both carryover funds awarded for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2015 and the new award for FFY 2016. The FFY 2015 HSGP funds have a three year performance period concluding June 2018. The FFY 2016 HSGP funds have a performance period of three years, concluding June 2019.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

A budget adjustment in the amount of \$51,029 is requested to transfer funds already budgeted in the approved FY2016-17 budget for the HSGP budget unit 213 under Special Department Expense (1100-213-2123) to the fixed asset line items. This transfer will cover purchases of an Automated Vehicle Locator for Humboldt Bay Fire District and Thermal Imaging Cameras for Fortuna Volunteer District. Both purchases were approved last fiscal year, however, the equipment was not available until now.

When the department's budget was approved by your Board in June 2016, the final HSGP award for FFY 2016 was not yet known and a large portion of the budgeted funds were assigned to 1100-213-2123 Special Department Expense as a placeholder. Now that the final a ward has been announced, a supplemental budget adjustment in the amount of \$51,029 is requested to transfer funds from 1100-213-2123 to specific fixed asset line items to enable purchases of items approved by the funding agency and described above.

The total award for the 2016-2019 performance period equals \$212,099, with an additional \$146,370 in unspent carryover funds from FFY 2015. The County also receives 5% in administrative funds at the end of each project year to cover the costs of program support. HSGP allowable expenditures are 100% reimbursable and there will be no impact to the General Fund.

The supplemental budget adjustment meets the Board of Supervisors Strategic Framework Plan goal of providing community-appropriate levels of service by managing resources in order to ensure sustainability of services.

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board could deny the request to approve the supplemental budget, however, this is not recommended as Budget Unit 213 for the Homeland Security Grant Program would be unable to meet obligations approved by the funding agency and the local Board of Directors.
