Celebrating College of the Redwoods' 50th Year

WHEREAS, in 2014, College of the Redwoods is celebrating 50 years of excellence in providing academic and career technical training for the North Coast community; and

WHEREAS, Humboldt County voted on January 14, 1964 to create the Redwoods Community College District, passed a \$3.6 million bond measure to build educational facilities and elected trustees from seven different areas; and

WHEREAS, the first CR classes were held at Eureka High School on September 13, 1965; and

WHEREAS, groundbreaking ceremonies took place on the Eureka campus on September 19, 1965; and

WHEREAS, classes were held for the first time on the Eureka campus on September 25, 1967; and

WHEREAS, College of the Redwoods has made major contributions to the economy and culture of Humboldt, Del Norte and Northwest Mendocino counties as well as to the prosperity of its students; and

WHEREAS, College of the Redwoods for five decades has continuously evolved to meet the basic skills, career technical education and academic transfer needs of its students; and

WHEREAS, College of the Redwoods will host a 50th Anniversary Party on the Eureka campus from 4 to 6 p.m. on Saturday, October 4, 2014.
