You Can Help: Recognize invitations

- Talk, threats about suicide, death, dying
- · Looking for ways to kill self
- · Past suicide attempt
- Feeling hopeless, trapped, like a burden
- Increase use of alcohol, other drug, relapse
- Changes in behavior, appearance, mood
- · Anger, rage, anxiety, agitation

Show: You care

- Offer help: I'm here for you.
- Listen calmly without judgment
- · Take all talk of suicide seriously

Voice: Your concerns

- I care about you. I'm worried.
- I've noticed you...missing work, etc.
- I'm listening...what is going on for you?
- Have you been thinking of suicide?

Provide: Support & connect

Let's talk to a counselor, parents, partner, spouse, teacher, coach, etc.

I will...go with you, contact you later, etc. Let's call the Suicide Prevention Lifeline.
