To Whom it may concern,

The following are corrective actions that will be made as a result of the inspection that occurred on April 25, 2023. A follow up report with pictures and receipts will be submitted by the end of May.

Item No.	Item
1	Excessive amount of trash and trellis netting present on the property
Response	All trash and trellis netting will be collected and taken to the Recology waste facility in Fortuna. Pictures and receipts will be provided upon completion.
2	Remove two decommissioned water bladders.
Response	Both bladders will be cut up into smaller pieces and removed by hand. During the removal process, no machinery will be used. The material will be transported to the Recology waste facility in Fortuna for disposal. Pictures and receipts will be provided.
3	Wildlife Entrapment Ramp
Response	An exit ramp will be installed in the rain catchment pond to prevent possible wildlife entrapment. The exit ramp shall be installed at no greater than 2:1 slope, securely fixed at the upslope end, and made of a solid material (e.g., compacted earth or wood). Photos will be provided to CDFW.
4	Delinquent Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement requirements
Response	A minor amendment will be submitted to CDFW to extend the work completion date of the 7 stream crossings. The applicant will begin having a Stream Restoration Plan developed and Bullfrog Monitoring reports from previous years will be submitted.
