My concerns for this grow, are the following; First the unsightly and huge steel tank that has been left laying in our neighborhood near Tim Mullen road. The tank is rusted, unsightly and looks to be abandon like a piece of garbage along side of the road. Next the water on Kneeland is limited to a few area's where gravelly knowles catch rain water and then produce some water for a spring or a well. This water is replenished during the winter rainy season. We are currently in a drought that who knows how long it will last. These commercial grows take away from the limited water supply being used by neighboring homes, that were using the limited water before the grower started business. This is putting additional strain on the home owners, where water is limited.

Please advise these growers to seek land to grow on, in area's away from established neighborhood's.
