We have lived at 1759 Old Arcata Rd, Bayside, since 1989. Over the last 33 years we've seen countless accidents at the intersection of Old Arcata Rd and Jacoby Creek Roads. The latest—just a few weeks ago when a drunk took out the stop sign at the intersection and then crossed OAR and went into our neighbor's yard. We are a few houses North of the intersection. Vehicles regularly speed by our house in excess of 50 mph. The majority of those living on the road favor the the proposed improvement project with the roundabout.
