That by the adoption of Resolution \_\_\_, the Board of Supervisors approves the Suggested Modification: the text amendment to the Trinidad Area Plan (Land Use Plan) amending development policies of Section 3.23-B-1; authorize the Planning staff to transmit the adopted changes to the California Coastal Commission for final certification; finds that the amendments will be effective immediately upon certification by the California Coastal Commission; agrees to issue Coastal Development Permits subject to the approved Local Coastal Program, and intends to carry out these amendments in a manner in conformity with the Coastal Act; and directs the Clerk of the Board to give notice of the decision to the applicant/owner, the County Assessor's Office, and any other interested party.
