Project Description

The project is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately 3.25 miles southwest of the town of Miranda. Following is a description of the improvements to public and private roads we have made for the specific purpose of protecting water quality in streams, creeks and rivers.

On April 18, 2019 we entered into a Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement (LSAA) with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW). This agreement required replacing and/or upgrading three culverts crossing Howard Ln.


The first culvert we replaced was 40' of 12" corrugated metal pipe (CMP) with 40' of 18" CMP. The existing culvert was undersized, 90% blocked and rusted out, therefore, erosion was occurring beneath the pipe. This culvert carries water from a drainage reserve ditch to an un-named tributary to Salmon Creek to the Eel River. This culvert was installed with a 6% grade. This work was completed in July 2020 and inspected and approved by the CDFW.

The second culvert we replaced was 20' of 18" CMP with 20' of 18" CMP. The existing culvert was 60% plugged, 100% rusted out and non-functioning. Erosion was occurring beneath the pipe. This culvert carries water from an unnamed tributary to Salmon Creek to the Eel River. This culvert was installed with a 4% grade. This project was completed in July 2020 and inspected and approved by CDFW.


The third culvert we replaced was 30' of 36" CMP with 30' of 48" CMP. This culvert was undersized which could have resulted in a breach which would cause significant soil erosion. The culvert was also out of alignment with channel's natural path, causing soil erosion at the outlet. This culvert was installed with a 9% grade. This work was completed and inspected in October 2021 and we are awaiting final approval from CDFW.

The fourth project we completed was to pave the existing private dirt/gravel driveway (Grenz Ln at Thomas Rd) and replace 40' of 12" CMP with 40' of 18" CMP within the right-of-way of Thomas Rd. This culvert was undersized, 100% blocked, rusted out and non-functioning. This paving work greatly reduced the amount of road dust entering the public road and ultimately the public drainage facilities that carry water to Salmon Creek and the Eel River. This work was completed in June 2021 in accordance with the Humboldt County Department of Public Works under Encroachment Permit 21078.

Your consideration of these improvements for grant funding is greatly appreciated.

Scope of Work

The culvert replacement work done along Howard Lane was completed by the owner (Jeff Van Dyke) and one laborer. In each case the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) was contacted within the 7-day period preceding the start of work and within 7 days after the work was fully completed. Neither the drainage reserve ditch nor un-named creeks were flowing when the work was performed.

The culverts were installed to grade, aligned with the natural stream channel and extended lengthwise beyond the toe of the fill. The culvert beds were composed of compacted (rock-free) soil. The crossing backfill material was free of rocks, limbs or other debris (to prevent water from seeping around the pipe) and was compacted. Both culvert inlets and outlets were armored with riprap. A swale was constructed above the pipe to ensure that any water run-off would be carried to the culvert. New road gravel was placed over all three culvert replacement projects.

The paving of the existing dirt/gravel driveway (Grenz Ln at Thomas Rd) and the replacement of the failing culvert was done in accordance with County of Humboldt Commercial Driveway No. 1 specifications and Encroachment Permit #21078. We hired Blackstone Construction for the paving and culvert replacement work. The driveway was constructed of asphalt concrete. Overall the approach was surfaced approximately 18' in width by 90' back from the existing Thomas Rd right-of-way. The project also included surfacing for turning movements to and from Grenz Ln and Thomas Rd (this consisted of a 35' driveway apron).

The roadway culvert was damaged, blocked and undersized, therefore, was replaced with a 40' of 18" corrugated metal pipe (CMP). All runoff from the roadway approach was directed to the new culvert and/or existing drainage facilities at the edge of the County road surface.

Erosion Control Plan and Monitoring Plan

Erosion Control Plan

Roads will be maintained with adequate surfacing and drainage features to avoid developing ruts, gullies or surface erosion that results in sediment delivery to surface waters. This includes rolling dips, roadside drainage ditches and adding road gravel as needed, or at least annually.

Culvert inlets and outlets will be inspected regularly to ensure that they are free of any obstructions. Also, drainage ditches that supply water to the culverts will be free and clear of any obstructions.

Hay was placed along the banks of each of the culverts and the banks were seeded with native clover.

The driveway approach will be maintained as to ensure that any surface water runoff is directed into either the roadway culvert or drainage facilities along the edge of Thomas Rd.

Monitoring Plan

As the applicants are also the residents of this parcel, the improvements will be monitored almost daily during trips to and from the parcel. More detailed monitoring will occur monthly by physical inspection and correction of any defect.



Equipment Operator salary in California




