1. Subrecipient	The Subrecipient is the unit of government or community based organization (CBO) that will have legal responsibility for these grant funds (e.g. County of Alameda, City of Fresno or Women's Place of Merced). Enter the legal name of the Subrecipient that is registered with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). PLEASE NOTE: that all CBOs must be registered, active, and current with the IRS, Department of Justice (DOJ), and Secretary of State (SOS) websites.
