RESOLUTION NO. 22-113

ADOPTING AND SETTING THE TAX RATES FOR THE FISCAL YER 2022-23 SECURED TAX ROLL

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt is required by California Government Code Section 29100 to adopt the rates of taxes on the secured roll prior to October 3rd, not to exceed the one-percent limitation specified in Article XIII A of the California Constitution Sections 93 and 100; and

WHEREAS, for voter-approved indebtedness, the Bord of Supervisors shall adopt the rates on the secured roll by determining the percentage of full value of property on the secured roll legally subject to support the annual debt requirement; and

WHEREAS, amounts needed for annual voter-approved debt payments, and the respective tax rates required to raise such amounts, have been determined by the County Auditor-Controller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt sets the tax rates for the 2022-23 Secured Roll at the rates specified herein.

BASIC AD VALOREM TAX RATE

The County shall levy an ad valorem property tax on taxable assessed value of property within the County of Humboldt at a tax rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per one hundred (\$100.00) of assessed value (as the terms "tax rate" and "assessed value" are defined in Section 135 of the Revenue and Taxation Code). The revenue from such tax shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of Revenue and Taxation Code, Division 1, Part 0.5, Chapter 6 and other applicable laws.

ADDITIONAL TAX RATES FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OR OTHER INDEBTEDNESS

The following tax rates are in addition to the one dollar (\$1.00) per one hundred (\$100.00) of assessed value tax rate levy set forth above and are for the purpose of making annual payments for interest and principal on voter approved general obligation bonds or other indebtedness of the school districts and local agencies in the County of Humboldt.
