Smoke Alarms – In accordance with the California Building Code, properly functioning smoke alarms shall be installed in each bedroom, with at least one at every level of the STR, including basements and lofts.

Carbon Monoxide Alarms -In accordance with the California Building Code, properly functioning carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed outside each bedroom and on every level of the STR, including basements and lofts, or any room with a fuel burning appliance.

Fire Extinguishers -Each STR shall have a minimum of one (1) five-pound fire extinguisher, type 3-A:40-B:C, readily available near the kitchen. If the STR has multiple levels, a minimum of one (1) fire extinguisher must be mounted within each level. Fire Extinguishers shall be inspected annually by a certified professional to ensure the extinguishers are functioning properly. Extinguishers shall have tag/receipt which shows last inspection date.
