County of Humboldt Proclamation International Walk to School Day October 8, 2014

WHEREAS, walking is an effective means to improve health and contributes to a safer community; and

WHEREAS, a lack of physical activity plays a leading role in rising rates of obesity, diabetes, and other health problems among youth and walking or biking to school offers an opportunity to build physical activity into their daily routine; and

WHEREAS, driving students to school by private vehicle contributes to traffic congestion and air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the County of Humboldt supports programs dedicated to improving the quality of life for our youth and believes that youth need guidance and encouragement to help develop and continue healthy lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, the County of Humboldt recognizes the need for and value of school crossing guards to help keep our students safe, and is working together with Eureka City Schools and the City of Eureka to launch a pilot volunteer crossing guard program; and

WHEREAS, the County of Humboldt leads Safe Routes to Schools efforts including infrastructure improvements and educational programs throughout the county to increase safety and coordination for youth walking and biking to school;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors:

- Proclaims October 8, 2014 as International Walk to School Day throughout Humboldt County;
- II. Urges all citizens to consider the health and safety of children, the community, and the environment; and
- III. Encourages its residents and visitors to walk safely and to always be aware of pedestrians.
