#### DISCUSSION:

Court Security budget unit 260 provides contracted bailiff/courtroom security and inmate coordination to the Superior Courts, and security screening for the Courthouse entrances. Vacancies in deputies available to provide bailiff coverage have made it necessary to hire extra help staff and/or allow overtime to meet the needs of the courts.

The new contract with Securitas Security Services USA, Inc. approved by your Board on March 10, 2015, reflected long overdue pay increases for the contractor and exceeded budget projections in this fiscal year. Supplemental budget adjustment #1 was approved by your Board on July 21, 2015; however, that request was insufficient to cover the final June billing, nor did it address extra help and overtime budget shortages.

Supplement budget request #2 in the amount of \$58,628 will clear outstanding expenses for the prior fiscal year and allow for year end close-out of the Court Security budget unit.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

Supplemental budget request #2 in the amount of \$58,628 is necessary to cover the over-expenditure of line items in Category 1 Salaries & Benefits – Extra Help and Overtime, as well as Services and Supplies Category 2, as indicated on page one. Revenue for Trial Court Security has also exceeded original projections and is sufficient to cover these additional expenses. If approved, request #2 will have no impact on the General Fund.

The supplemental budget adjustment meets the Board of Supervisors Strategic Framework Plan goal of providing community-appropriate levels of service.

# **ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:**

The Board could deny the request to approve supplemental budget request #2, however, this is not recommended as Budget Unit 260 for Court Security would be overdrawn and unable to meet obligations for fiscal year 2014-15.
