- APPOINTING POWER:** Board of Supervisors
- MEMBERS:** Fifteen (15)
- QUALIFICATIONS:** The Board of Supervisors is encouraged to appoint individuals who have
experience and knowledge of the mental health system.

The membership should reflect the ethnic diversity of the client population in the County.

50% of the membership **shall** be consumers or the parent, spouse, sibling or adult children of consumers, who are receiving or have received mental health services. At least 20% of the total membership **shall** be consumers, and at least 20% **shall** be families of consumers.

One member of the Board of Supervisors shall be on the board.

No member of the board nor his/her spouse shall be a full-time or part-time county employee of a county mental health service, an employee of the State Department of Mental Health, or an employee of, or a paid member of a governing body of, a Bronzan-McCorguodale contract agency.

APPOINTING POWER: Board

MEMBERS: (7) Seven voting members.

District 1 Supervisor will appoint (3) voting members to a (2) year term after which their term expires (3) new members shall be appointed for a 4 year term.

Initially the full Board of Supervisors, by majority vote, shall appoint (2) voting members to a 4-year term. After their initial term has expired, the full Board of Supervisors, by majority vote, shall thereafter appoint two (2) members serving 4-year terms.

TERM: Four (4) Years

FUNCTION: Gathering input from community and commenting on matters of concerns which relate to County services including but not limited to public works, health, safety, welfare and public financing. GEAMAC also is responsible for the review, comment and provide advisory recommendation to the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors on proposed zoning amendments and General Plan petitions and amendment located with the GEAMAC area.
