To whom it May Concern (i.e. Humboldt County Citizens Advisory Committee on Measure Z and Humboldt County Board of Supervisors):

We, as trustees of the Mattole Unified School District, and parents, all of whom have children who attend schools in our district, are writing to express our concerns about the deplorable state of the roads in the Mattole Valley.

The students in our district travel the roads to and from school every day, and all of them, including Mattole Road, which connects our two school sites, one in Honeydew and the other in Petrolia, are strewn with numerous large and unavoidable potholes. These obstructions often cause vehicles to have to swerve to avoid them creating unsafe conditions for all of the residents in the Valley.

Other main roads upon which our bus travels, such as Lighthouse, and a road close to the school upon which many students reside, Chambers Road, are so badly maintained that there are stretches where it is impossible not to hit a pothole no matter how skillfully one drives.

We are hopeful that you will consider allocating a substantial or at least adequate amount of Measure Z funds to resurfacing and comprehensively repairing and maintaining our roads so as to ensure the safety of the students and other residents of the Mattole Valley.

- Where uncontrolled fire is growing larger through lack of timberland management and letting snags and fire fuel levels build.
- Where the richest timberland in the world, the redwoods, especially in Humboldt County, are being put into preservations and parks like the least visited Redwood National Park.
- Where Humboldt Bay is not fully utilized
- Where many timber owners are finding growing trees is a bad investment as timber producing lands, privately owned timber land is sold, and privately owned open space is being eliminated.
- Where economic dependence will depend on marijuana growing which will go in the tank as soon as marijuana is legalized and the big guys take over.
- Where tourism, farming, and other industries are replacing the by-far lost, better paying, and tax generating timber industry jobs.
- Where creation of food and habitats liked by spotted owls, deer, mountain lions, fisheries, and other wanted species is being reduced.
