Dear Humboldt County Board of Supervisors:

The Redwood ACLU joins with the Human Rights Commission and supports the call to declare a Shelter Crisis in the petition circulated by the non-profit group Affordable Homeless Housing Alternatives, known as AHHA.

Declaration of a Shelter Crisis can make available public owned/operated/leased/maintained properties for use by persons unable to obtain housing. A Shelter Crisis declaration provides the County immunity from liability for ordinary negligence related to this use. During the crisis the provisions of any state or local regulatory statute, regulation, or ordinance setting standards of housing, health, or safety are suspended if it would in any way prevent, hinder or delay improving the situation.

The only thing common to all homeless people is that they do not have stable, traditional housing. The shelters and social services are struggling, there are not enough beds for the night. During the day people face laws against sitting or lying down.

The County 2015 Point in Time Count indicates an increase in the number of homeless people over the 2013 Count and an increase, from 485 to 844, in unsheltered persons. For the first time, the Count indicates there are more unsheltered people than those sleeping in shelters, transitional/supportive housing, or motels. These numbers represent a crisis.

AHHA's petition also calls for a county-wide Task Force to develop services and land access to successfully relocate all homeless people temporarily into multiple legal sanctuary camps in SB2 areas. The Redwood ACLU supports a public process to make additional improvements through a task force. When a task force is created we encourage the inclusion of private individuals with extensive experience among the homeless in addition to representatives from public and private non-profit groups. The Redwood ACLU would be willing and able to participate through a representative with a background in housing, poverty, and homeless issues.

However declaring a crisis and designating public facilities should be the first priority. Removing the stress and stigma of being illegal because your house is your car or a tent or

makeshift shelter, is an important first step to encourage more and support ongoing private efforts.

The Redwood ACLU supports a declaration of Shelter Crisis to immediately designate public property where those subject to the "illegal lodging" laws can live legally. We encourage you to act as swiftly as possible to instruct staff to identify available locations and draft a declaration for your approval.

TITLE 2. GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

(*Title 2 enacted by Stats. 1943, Ch. 134.*)

DIVISION 1. GENERAL

(*Division 1 enacted by Stats. 1943, Ch. 134.*)

CHAPTER 7.8. Shelter Crisis [8698 - 8698.2]

(*Chapter 7.8 added by Stats. 1987, Ch. 1116, Sec. 2.*)

8698. For purposes of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply:

- (a) "Political subdivision" includes the state, any city, city and county, county, special district, or school district or public agency authorized by law.
- (b) "Governing body" means the following:
 - (1) The Governor for the state.
 - (2) The legislative body for a city or city and county.
 - (3) The board of supervisors for a county.
 - (4) The governing board or board of trustees for a district or other public agency.
 - (5) An official designated by ordinance or resolution adopted by a governing body, as defined in paragraph (2), (3), or (4).
- (c) "Public facility" means any facility of a political subdivision including parks, schools, and vacant or underutilized facilities which are owned, operated, leased, or maintained, or any combination thereof, by the political subdivision through money derived by taxation or assessment.
- (d) "Declaration of a shelter crisis" means the duly proclaimed existence of a situation in which a significant number of persons are without the ability to obtain shelter, resulting in a threat to their health and safety.

(Amended by Stats. 1988, Ch. 748, Sec. 1.)

8698.1. Upon a declaration of a shelter crisis, the following provisions shall apply during the period of the emergency.

(a) **The political subdivision shall be immune from liability for ordinary negligence in the provision of emergency housing** pursuant to Section 8698.2. This limitation of liability shall apply only to conditions, acts, or omissions directly related to, and which would not occur but for, the provision of emergency housing. This section does not limit liability for grossly negligent, reckless, or intentional conduct which causes injury.

(b) **The provisions of any state or local regulatory statute, regulation, or ordinance prescribing standards of housing, health, or safety shall be suspended** to the extent that strict compliance would in any way prevent, hinder, or delay the mitigation of the effects of the shelter crisis. **Political subdivisions may, in place of such standards, enact municipal health and safety standards to be operative during the housing emergency** consistent with ensuring minimal public health and safety. The provisions of this section apply only to additional public facilities open to the homeless pursuant to this chapter.

(Added by Stats. 1987, Ch. 1116, Sec. 2. Effective September 25, 1987.)

8698.2. (a) (1) The governing body may declare a shelter crisis, and may take such action as is necessary to carry out the provisions of this chapter, **upon a finding by that governing body that a significant number of persons within the jurisdiction of the governing body are without the ability to obtain shelter, and that the situation has resulted in a threat to the health and safety of those persons.**

(2) For purposes of this chapter, the governing body of the state, in making a declaration of a shelter crisis pursuant to paragraph (1), may limit that declaration to any geographical portion of the state.

(b) **Upon a declaration of a shelter crisis** pursuant to subdivision (a), **the political subdivision may allow persons unable to obtain housing to occupy designated public facilities during the duration of the state of emergency.**

(Added by Stats. 1987, Ch. 1116, Sec. 2. Effective September 25, 1987.)

AHHA Petition to Declare a Shelter Crisis 9/1/2015.

We, the Citizens of Eureka and Humboldt County do hereby request that the City of Eureka and the County of Humboldt declare a Shelter Crisis, pursuant to California Government Code Chapter 7.8. Shelter Crisis SECTION 8698-2.

Whereas: This legal remedy states "upon a finding by that governing body that a significant number of persons within the jurisdiction of the governing body are without the ability to obtain shelter, and that situation has resulted in a threat to the health and safety of those persons.

Whereas: CHAPTER 633, Senate Bill No. 2, sets forth requirements for local planning and housing element provisions that add emergency shelters to these provisions, as specified. Our local government has identified zones throughout the county, where emergency shelters are allowed as a permitted use without a conditional use or other discretionary permit and authorizes a local government to satisfy all or part of this requirement by adopting and implementing a multijurisdictional agreement.

Whereas: The 2015 Point in Time Count indicated 1,319 homeless living in Humboldt County, and not enough available shelter beds or low income housing stock available.

Whereas: The Department of Justice has recently ruled that people cannot be deprived of their right to sleep, and Eureka and Humboldt County are unnecessarily headed toward violation of human rights by their current proposed eviction actions without a legal place for people to move. Property destruction by the city of Eureka and the County of Humboldt also opens our governing bodies to probably lawsuits for violation of property rights.

Therefore, we are calling for 1) a Declaration of a Humboldt County and Eureka City Shelter Crisis and 2) a county-wide Task Force that includes representatives from all homeless stakeholder groups to develop services and land access to successfully relocate all homeless people temporarily into multiple legal sanctuary camps in SB2 areas UNTIL there are adequate and accessible shelter beds or low income housing available to these persons.

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



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1. FAIR ARGUMENT STANDARD

Legal standard for determining the significance of impacts; whether a “fair argument” can be made that a “substantial adverse change in physical conditions” will occur.

EIR is required if fair argument exists that a project may have a significant effect on the environment.

Fair argument must be backed by substantial evidence

Generally does not matter how much evidence supports a less-than-significant effect, when a “fair argument” exists

If competing evidence exists, lead agency must prepare an EIR

2. SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE DEFINED

Includes fact, reasonable assumption predicated upon fact, or expert opinion supported by fact

Does not include argument, speculation, unsubstantiated opinion, erroneous information, or evidence of social or economic impact that do not cause or contribute to physical environmental effects (PRC §21080(e))

3. TYPES OF SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE

Agency staff reports, opinions

Expert opinion based on facts

Technical studies

Public comments

Prior planning documents, prior EIRs

4. SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE AND FAIR ARGUMENT EXERCISE

Could a significant water quality impact occur?

Which is basis for substantial evidence supporting a fair argument?:

(a) A lead agency shall find that a project may have a significant effect on the environment and thereby require an EIR to be prepared for the project where there is substantial evidence, in light of the whole record, that any of the following conditions may occur:

(1) The project has the potential to substantially degrade the quality of the environment; substantially reduce the habitat of a fish or wildlife species; cause a fish or wildlife population to drop below self-sustaining levels; threaten to eliminate a plant or animal community; substantially reduce the number or restrict the range of an endangered, rare or threatened species; or eliminate important examples of the major periods of California history or prehistory.

(2) The project has the potential to achieve short-term environmental goals to the disadvantage of long-term environmental goals.

(3) The project has possible environmental effects that are individually limited but cumulatively considerable. "Cumulatively considerable" means that the incremental effects of an individual project are significant when viewed in connection with the effects of past projects, the effects of other current projects, and the effects of probable future projects.

(4) The environmental effects of a project will cause substantial adverse effects on human beings, either directly or indirectly.

(b)(1) Where, prior to the commencement of preliminary public review of an environmental document, a project proponent agrees to mitigation measures or project modifications that would avoid any significant effect on the environment specified by subdivision (a) or would mitigate the significant effect to a point where clearly no significant effect on the environment would occur, a lead agency need not prepare an environmental impact report solely because, without mitigation, the environmental effects at issue would have been significant.

(2) Furthermore, where a proposed project has the potential to substantially reduce the number or restrict the range of an endangered, rare or threatened species, the lead agency need not prepare an EIR solely because of such an effect, if:

(A) the project proponent is bound to implement mitigation requirements relating to such species and habitat pursuant to an approved habitat conservation plan or natural community

conservation plan;

ii. MANDATORY FINDINGS:ENDANGERED, RARE, OR THREATENED SPECIES

Where a project may substantially reduce the number or

(B) the state or federal agency approved the habitat conservation plan or natural community conservation plan in reliance on an environmental impact report or environmental impact statement; and

(C) 1. such requirements avoid any net loss of habitat and net reduction in number of the affected species, or

2. such requirements preserve, restore, or enhance sufficient habitat to mitigate the reduction in habitat and number of the affected species to below a level of significance.

(c) Following the decision to prepare an EIR, if a lead agency determines that any of the conditions specified by subdivision (a) will occur, such a determination shall apply to:

(1) the identification of effects to be analyzed in depth in the environmental impact report or the functional equivalent thereof,

(2) the requirement to make detailed findings on the feasibility of alternatives or mitigation measures to substantially lessen or avoid the significant effects on the environment,

(3) when found to be feasible, the making of changes in the project to substantially lessen or avoid the significant effects on the environment, and

(4) where necessary, the requirement to adopt a statement of overriding considerations.
