## **SOURCE OF FUNDING:** General Fund – Fees for Service

**DISCUSSION:** Due to the overwhelmingly positive public response to the Commercial Medical Marijuana Land Use Ordinance (CMMLUO), the Current Planning Division of the Planning and Building Department is experiencing extraordinary demands on its resources. In response, the department instituted a special hotline designed to provide applicants and interested parties a way to speak to a live person. A similar strategy was employed during public comment periods for the General Plan Update. In just over three months, the department has responded to nearly 500 phone inquiries received through the cannabis services hotline. Additionally, the Planner-on-Duty program offered by the department has been fielding a greater-than-average number of interested parties walking in to the office for information related to processing permits outlined in the CMMLUO.

#### **Estimated Number of Cultivation sites**

Research co-authored by Van Butsic of UC Berkeley verified the existence of 4,200 discrete cultivation sites in Humboldt County. As noted during a presentation made to the Board of Supervisors on January 12<sup>th</sup> 2016, estimates of cultivation sites were based on a random sample of roughly half of the county's subwatersheds. Mr. Butsic suggested during the presentation that it was safe to double that number for a more accurate count of cultivation sites. Additionally, as the study was primarily based on 2012 data, the number of cultivation sites fails to account for continued expansion of the industry between 2012 and the present.

Early signals of Participation

Upon adoption of a Waiver of Waste Discharge (Order No. 2015-0023), the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) reports participation from nearly 400 farms in Humboldt County. Recent conversations with key RWQCB staff confirm that many more are expected in the months ahead.

In consultation with the County Administrative Office, the department is initiating the creation of a new division, titled the Cannabis Services Division (1100-268). Previously approved additional staffing allocations will be migrated to the new division, effective July 1, 2016. In order to provide organizational structure appropriate to the new division, the department is requesting that the Board approve the allocation of a Supervising Planner position, effective July 1, 2016.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT**: Fees related to these anticipated permits are expected to generate revenue to offset the additional staffing expense which will occur as the result of approving the additional staffing allocation. The salary and benefit costs for the new position are estimated to be \$100,000 annually.

Approval of the additional staffing allocation assists the department in meeting the goals outlined by the Board of Supervisors in its Strategic Framework. The Cannabis Services Division's work in cannabis-related permitting processes is designed to support the goals outlined in the Strategic Framework by supporting the department as it enforces regulations that protect residents, as it creates opportunities for improved safety and health, as it encourages new local enterprise and ensures proper operation of markets and as it provides community-appropriate levels of service. The use of professional, qualified planning consultants will allow the department to process applications related to cannabis services so that local applicants meet local ordinance deadlines and are poised to participate in the state program.

## **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT**: None

<u>ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: The Board may choose not to approve this staffing allocation; however this is not recommended as it would negatively impact the ability of the department to meet the anticipated demand for building permits and permits related to the medical marijuana ordinance.
