## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT

WHEREAS, Charlene Pellatz retired on July 29, 2016 after 13 years of service to the people of Humboldt County in her role at Public Health; and

WHEREAS, Charlene spent 46 years in nursing, 40 of which were in leadership positions; and

WHEREAS, Charlene started the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program with federal funding provided after the 9/11 tragedy and has had oversight of it, as well as Pandemic Flu and Hospital Preparedness Grants during her tenure with the County; and

WHEREAS, during the 2009 – 2010 H1N1 Pandemic Flu crisis, Charlene was instrumental in setting up public H1N1 immunization clinics, clinics in local schools, as well as coordinating Public Health employees, who did 70 presentations to educate residents on the benefits of getting immunized; and

WHEREAS, Charlene has played a leadership role during air quality issues relating to wildfires, including working with community members and tribal governments on coordination efforts; and

WHEREAS, prior to her employment with the County of Humboldt, Public Health Department, Charlene served our community as a Nursing Supervisor, Director of Nurses and Assistant Hospital Administrator in acute care hospitals; and

WHEREAS, since 2004 Charlene and Carl Pellatz have volunteered to run food and refreshment concessions for the Humboldt Crabs, keeping the fans happy and generating revenue for the team; and

WHEREAS, in her retirement, Charlene plans to do a lot of traveling, spend time with family, especially her grandchildren, and continue volunteering her time to worthy causes like the Humboldt Crabs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby commends and thanks Charlene Pellatz for her dedication and years of service to our community, and wish her a long, happy and well deserved retirement.
