RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors authorize temporary increase in pay for Senior Fiscal Assistant, Brittany Nelson (Class 0124, Range 343) as though promoted to Fiscal Services Supervisor (Class 1149, Range 372) beginning December 18, 2016 and continuing until the incumbent returns.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Social Services Fund

DISCUSSION:

On November 20, 2016 Ms. Nelson assumed the principle duties of the Fiscal Services Supervisor in accordance with Section 12.4.1 of the AFSCME Memorandum of Understanding for a total of 20 consecutive work days; which ends December 17, 2016. The Department of Health and Human Services is requesting that the Board of Supervisors approve continuance of the acting supervisor salary until the incumbent returns from approved leave.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The increased monthly cost of a Fiscal Services Supervisor (Class 1149, Range 372) from a Senior Fiscal Assistant, Brittany Nelson (Class 0124, Range 343) is \$302.39 through December 31, 2016 and \$308.46 effective January 1, 2017. Approval of the continuance of the acting supervisor from December 18,2016 until the incumbent returns from approved leave, is estimated at \$1,988.21 for the remainder of the 2016-17 fiscal year. This position resides in fund 1160, budget unit 511 (Social Services) and is funded through federal, state and local funds. There is sufficient appropriation to cover this request due to unexpected salary savings. There is no impact to the county general fund.

Approving this recommendation will support the Board's Strategic Framework by providing and maintaining infrastructure.
