unincorporated areas of the county. In the FY 2016-17 budget proposal approved by the Board of Supervisors on June 28, 2016, the Sheriff included four additional Deputy Sheriff positions, to be assigned as resident deputies throughout the county. The increased staffing in the last two budget years require that additional patrol vehicles be added to the motor pool for use by the Sheriff's Office.

The FY 2016-17 approved funding included the purchase of three new patrol vehicles and one new SUV from Measure Z Budget Unit 297. For purposes of capitalization, maintenance and insurance the Sheriff's Office wishes to donate the four vehicles purchased in the current budget year to the County motor pool.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The approved FY 2016-17 budget for Sheriff's Measure Budget Unit 297 includes funding in the amount of \$118,558 in fixed asset line 1100-297-8777 for the purchase of three patrol vehicles and one SUV vehicle to be used by the Sheriff's Office in various locations within the unincorporated areas of the county. Funds have been allocated and no additional funding or impact to the General Fund is necessary to facilitate the donation of these vehicles to the County motor pool.

The donation of four Sheriff's vehicles to the County motor pool meets the Board of Supervisors Strategic Plan by providing community-appropriate levels of service.
