SOURCE OF FUNDING: Aviation Capital Projects - Airport Improvement Program 03-06-0092-009 (AIP-09) and Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) 12 funds.

DISCUSSION: On December 15, 2015, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Chair to sign the Agreement for Consultant Services for Garberville Airport (O16) Runway and Taxiway Rehabilitation and Run-Up Apron Design with Mead and Hunt.

In Fiscal Year 2015-16 two checks were issued to Mead & Hunt, one in the amount of \$37,662.45 and the other in the amount of \$19,891.57. Mead & Hunt reported in November 2016 that these checks were lost. The lost checks were subsequently cancelled by the county and replacement checks were issued in November 2016. A supplemental budget is being requested to cover the replacement of these checks in FY 2016-17 as the original funds were budgeted in FY 2015-16. There is no
