#### DISCUSSION:

The Humboldt County Drug Task Force (DTF) is comprised of local law enforcement agencies that each dedicates staff to combat mid-level to major narcotic offenders in all jurisdictional boundaries of the County. Operating expenses for the DTF are provided through grants and state and federal asset forfeiture revenues. These asset forfeiture revenues are maintained in county trust funds and administered by the Sheriff's Office.

DTF intends to maintain a three-year operating budget amount in Trust 3644 SIB- Operating Expense to ensure the availability of continued resources for drug enforcement activities. Excess revenues are distributed annually to participating member agencies, per the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), with the last distribution in November 2015.

At the regular monthly Drug Task Force board meeting on January 11, 2017 the Executive Board voted in favor of a distribution of excess asset forfeiture funds to member agencies. The total distribution is explained in the table below and a supplemental adjustment to budget unit 1100-265 in the amount of \$372,744 is required to transfer funds from the trusts to an expense line item that will allow payments to local agencies.

Funds distributed to Humboldt County District Attorney and Sheriff's Office will be transferred from Trust 3644 to the appropriate department trust with a journal and are included in the total asset forfeiture distribution, however, not included in the supplemental request.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

A supplemental budget adjustment in budget unit 1100-265 Drug Task Force in the amount of \$372,744 is requested to cover the distribution of excess asset forfeiture revenues as described below. Trust 3644 balance as of December 31, 2016 totals \$1,533,984 and the trust will maintain a balance of \$540,000 after distribution, which is equal to approximately three years DTF operating expenses.
