## **PROCLAMATION**

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT

WHEREAS, AmeriCorps participants address the most pressing challenges facing our communities, from mentoring vulnerable students to supporting and advocating for veterans and families to providing services for homeless citizens and helping communities recover from natural disasters as well as agency capacity building and promoting energy efficiency and sustainability; and

WHEREAS, national service expands economic opportunity by creating more sustainable, resilient communities and providing education, career skills, and leadership abilities for those who serve; and

WHEREAS, AmeriCorps participants serve in more than 50,000 locations across the country, bolstering the civic, neighborhood, and faith-based organizations that are so vital to our economic and social well-being; and

WHEREAS, national service participants increase the impact of the organizations they serve, through their direct service and by managing millions of additional volunteers; and

WHEREAS, national service represents a unique public-private partnership that invests in community solutions and leverages non-federal resources to strengthen community impact and increase the return on taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, national service participants demonstrate commitment, dedication, and patriotism by making an intensive commitment to service, a commitment that remains with them in their future endeavors; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation for National and Community Service and California Volunteers is joining with county and other officials across the country in recognizing National AmeriCorps Week.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims March 5-11, 2017 as National AmeriCorps Week in Humboldt County, and encourages residents to recognize the positive impact of national service in our county, and to find ways to give back to their communities.
