Patrol vehicles. Motor Pool has no AWD Patrol vehicles left in storage and Motor Pool needs to pull five (5) currently used from service due to high mileage. Bids for these vehicles have been received. The cost of the five replacement vehicles is \$178,750. An additional funding request is needed to purchase these vehicles.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: The cost will be offset from the sale of the surplus vehicles in the amount of \$99,600. The balance of the Motor Pool fund as of January 31, 2017, was \$3.5 million. The recommended minimum fund balance for Motor Pool is \$2 million. There are sufficient funds available to purchase the five (5) replacement vehicles. This action will reduce the fund balance by \$33,000.

This item will advance the Board's core role, to provide community-appropriate levels of service.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT: None

<u>ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: The Board could deny the request for the additional vehicles. This is not recommended because it would result in a shortage of vehicles available for day-to-day use by the Sheriff Department.
