2. A reconciliation of the number of ballots counted, spoiled, or rejected due to damage;
3. Counting any valid write-in votes;
4. Reproducing any damaged ballots, if necessary;
5. Conducting a hand count of at least one percent of the ballots cast in the election; and
6. Reporting the final results as required.

Elections Code Section 15372 requires the county elections official to complete the official canvass no later than the 30th day after the election and submit a certified statement of the results to the governing body, the County Board of Supervisors.

Election Code Section 15400 states that the governing body shall declare elected or nominated to each office voted on at each election under its jurisdiction the person having the highest number of votes for that office.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

In conducting this special election for the district, the county has invited civic engagement while fostering transparent and accessible services.

The approximate cost for the election is \$40,000 which is billable to the district.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board could choose not to accept the Certified Statement of Results, but would then be out of compliance with Elections Code Section 15400.
