Nurse Case Manager Emily Barnes provides nurse case management, taking doctor's orders and processing refills and prior authorizations in order for clients to obtain medications. She also provides coverage in the clinic. Emily has been providing coverage for vacant positions and for staff on approved leave.

Vocational Assistant Shamieka Kiel provides support for Mobile Outreach. The demand has increased for support services from clients in outlying areas and clients who are homeless and served by Mobile Outreach and Street Outreach Services.

Mental Health Cook Aenoi Khounsinavong works in support of the 24-hour Psychiatric In-Patient Hospital providing coverage for staff on approved leave and position vacancies.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Mental Health assignments of Emily Barnes, Shamieka Kiel and Aenoi Khounsinavng will be funded through Mental Health fund; cost of these extra help positions are funded by Mental Health revenues from Medicare and Medicaid cost reimbursement, Behavioral Health Realignment allocations, Mental Health Services Act and Federal Mental Health Block Grant. The additional cost of extra help hours is \$38,409. There is sufficient appropriation in Mental Health Administration budget unit 1170-424 due to funded vacant positions for these additional extra help hours.

All extra help employees working beyond 960 hours are subject to paying into the California Public Employee Retirement System (PERS). The additional costs for PERS has been included in the above mentioned estimated salary costs. The department is aware that in accordance with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) extra help employees who have been identified as a full time employee under the ACA guidelines will be given the opportunity to enroll in the county's health insurance. Those employees will be identified by using the standard measurement period and associated stability period annual cycle set forth by those guidelines.

Approving the extension of extra help hours supports the Board's Strategic Framework by providing community-appropriate levels of service and creating opportunities for improved safety and health.
