WHEREAS, the Friends of the Redwood Libraries' Serendipity Book Store opened in October of 1999 as a result of Frances Rapin's idea to sell used books as a means to raise funds to meet some unbudgeted library needs; and

WHEREAS, The Serendipity Book Store's success can be attributed to the more than 55 dedicated volunteers who donate their time by working in the book store, receiving, sorting and pricing donations, stocking shelves, and coordinating sales events; as well as the generous donations from Humboldt County residents; and

WHEREAS, the Serendipity Book Store recently reached sales of \$500,000, which highlights the momentous extent of their success.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes and applauds the \$500,000 sales mark of the Serendipity Book Store and thanks the Friends of the Redwood Libraries for all they do to make the Humboldt County Library the cornerstone of our community.
