DISCUSSION: On March 21, 2017, the Board of Supervisors discussed the potential for developing a civil rights and diversity resolution in Humboldt County. At the time, Jim Glover, Chair of the Human Rights Commission addressed the Board and stated that the Human Rights Commission has been working on a similar recommendation in response to citizen concerns. He indicated that the Commission would be meeting again on April 6, 2017 to finalize a formal recommendation to the Board of Supervisors.

The Board then voted unanimously to have the Human Rights Commission bring back their recommendation to the April 11, 2017 Board Meeting for consideration. However, because of timing and publishing constraints of the Board's agenda, staff is requesting that this item be continued to the April 18th Board of Supervisors Agenda.
