WHEREAS, nurses are a part of prevention, primary care and long-term care in hospitals, clinics and community, public health, mental health and long-term care facilities; and

WHEREAS, more than 90 nurses in the Humboldt County Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) work to create a nurturing, supportive, healthy environment for Humboldt County children, families, adults and communities through innovative and integrative efforts between Public Health, Mental Health, Social Services, education and medical professionals; and

WHEREAS, National Nurses Week provides an opportunity to honor the work of DHHS nurses and all community nurses in their ongoing effort to promote, protect and enhance the health and safety of all residents in our county.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims May 6-12, 2017 as Nurses Week in Humboldt County and asks that all residents join in honoring the nurses who care for us all, and celebrate registered nursing's accomplishments and efforts to improve our health care system, and show our appreciation for the nation's nurses, not just during this week, but, at every opportunity throughout the year.
