Range 393, Step B to C (4/5 vote required)

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors approve an advance salary step increase for Nicholas Massey, Road Maintenance Supervisor (1200 325, 0204, 393) from step B to C, retroactive to April 23, 2017, the first day of Mr. Massey's promotion, pursuant to Section 7 of the Humboldt County Salary Resolution. (4/5 vote required)

SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Roads Fund (1200 325)

DISCUSSION:

On March 3, 2016, the Road Maintenance Supervisor of the Freshwater Road Crew went on extended leave. Mr. Massey was a Road Maintenance Worker III at the time and he agreed to cover the duties until June when the Supervisor was scheduled to return. On April 12, 2016, your Board agreed to compensate Mr. Massey for these additional duties; Board Order C-11 (Attachment 1). It became apparent that the Supervisor would not return in June and Mr. Massey again agreed to cover the additional duties. On May 24, 2016, your Board agreed to compensate him until the Supervisor returned or a replacement could be hired, Board Order C-24 (Attachment 2).

On April 23, 2017, Mr. Massey was promoted to Road Maintenance Supervisor. The Department of Public Works did request and received permission from the County Administrative Office (CAO) to place Mr. Massey at Salary Range 393, Step C (Attachment 3). According to Section 10.1.1, of the Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Humboldt and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), advance step increases can be pre-approved by the County Administrative Office before the date of hire, but salary advancement requests after the hire date must be authorized by the Board of Supervisors per Section 7 of the Salary Resolution.

Mr. Massey's skills and experience has provided benefits to the Public Works Road Division. He has been a county employee since 1999 and for over a year took on extra responsibilities and performed them well. His promotion should include a step increase so he is not paid the same amount that he has been for the past year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The proposed action will result in an estimated expenditure increase of \$870.72 in Fiscal Year 2016-17 and \$3,482.88 in Fiscal Year 2017-18.

The proposed action conforms to the Board's Strategic Framework by providing for and maintaining infrastructure.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT: None

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board of Supervisors could choose not to approve the salary step to C for Mr. Massey and maintain Step B. This alternative is not recommended because it is not an increase from his previous year's salary and is not fair compensation for his service.
