Garden; Tribal, Hmong, and Latino communities; and many other people and organizations
that make up the heart of Humboldt County; and

WHEREAS, Deborah is an excellent educator who has a wealth of knowledge on a wide variety of agricultural topics in addition to her skills and interests in family and business succession; cottage foods; dairy goats; and agriculture, nature, and heritage tourism.
