## FINANCIAL IMPACT

The increased monthly cost of a Director of Environmental Health (Class 0510, Range 507) from a Supervising Environmental Health Specialist, Amanda Ruddy, (Class 0519, Range 461) is \$679 48 Approval of the continuance of the acting supervisor from July 2, 2017 until the incumbent returns from approved leave, is estimated at \$1,019 24 and will be funded through Fund 1175, Budget Unit 406-Environmental Health Consumer Protection There is sufficient appropriation in the proposed Fiscal Year 2017-18 county budget to accommodate the cost increase due to vacancies There is no impact to the general fund
