RESOLUTION NO. 17-62

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF AVENUE OF THE GIANTS AND CONTROLLED TRAFFIC ON THE MATTOLE ROAD FOR THE HUMBOLDT REDWOODS MARATHON, HALF MARATHON AND 5K ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2017

WHEREAS, the Six Rivers Running Club is planning the Humboldt Redwoods Marathon, Half Marathon and 5K on Sunday, October 15, 2017 from 9:00 A.M. to 4 P.M. and is requesting that the following specific sections of Avenue of the Giants be closed temporarily with controlled traffic:

- Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit from Highway 101 to 6.55
 miles south of Dyerville Bridge closed to all traffic but official race and emergency
 vehicles. People attending church or leaving/returning home would be allowed to pass;
 and
- Both lanes of the Mattole Road controlled by Eureka Volunteer Patrol (EVP) pilot cars from the Dyerville Bridge (Honeydew Founders Tree exit from Highway 101) to a point 6.55 miles west on the Mattole Road; and

WHEREAS, the proposed staging area is in southern Humboldt County - the Dyerville Bridge/Overlook area and the surrounding roads. Vehicular traffic is affected for approximately 5 to 7 miles to the north, south, and west of the bridge/overlook area. The majority of the foot race course is held within the park, but also includes approximately 1.5miles of Humboldt County Mattole Road west of approximately 5.5 miles of park road; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation requires an adopted resolution from the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors authorizing the above closures.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors authorizes the temporary closure of Avenue of the Giants, the southbound Honeydew Exit, and the eastern portion of the Mattole Road on October 15, 2017 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. in order to allow the Six Rivers Running Club to conduct the Annual Avenue of the Giants Marathon; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the District One Director of the California Department of Transportation and to the Six Rivers Running Club.



Request for Temporary Road Closure

Dear Supervisor Fennell:

The Six Rivers Running Club would appreciate the placement of the following road closure request on the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors agenda. Although our event is not scheduled until October 15, 2017, the resolution, required by Caltrans and the California Highway Patrol, is an early step in our multi-agency permitting process. We sincerely appreciate the Board of Supervisors' consideration of our request.

The Six Rivers Running Club is requesting a temporary closure of the Avenue of the Giants, and controlled traffic on the Mattole Road for the 39th Annual Humboldt Redwoods Marathon, Half Marathon and 5K Race on Sunday, October 15, 2017 from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

The specific closure and traffic control areas are:

- Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit of Highway 101 to a
 point 6.55 miles south of the Dyerville Bridge. Route 254 will be closed to all
 traffic except for official race and emergency vehicles. Citizens attending church
 or leaving and returning home will also be allowed to pass through the temporary
 closure areas.
- The Bull Creek/Mattole Road, leading west from the Dyerville Bridge, will be subject to piloted traffic, controlled by Eureka Volunteer Patrol (EVP) pilot cars. Piloted traffic will extend for a distance of 6.55 miles west on the Mattole Road.

As in previous years, the closure and control traffic areas will be reviewed by Caltrans and the CHP.

Special Event Permits for the will be obtained from the County of Humboldt, California State Parks and Caltrans. Emergency Service agencies will be involved in event coordination and staged on site during the event.

Thank you for your continued support of our two major marathons (The Avenue of the Giants Marathon and the Humboldt Redwoods Marathon). Both events showcase the beauty of our County, bringing runners and their families to the North Coast from all over the United States.
