#### AMENDMENT NUMBER 1

# PROFESSIONAL SERVICS AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT AND

#### NORTHERN CALIFORNIA INDIAN DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL FOR FISCAL YEARS 2016-2017 THROUGH 2017-2018

The parties, the County of Humboldt, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and Northern California Indian Development Council (NCIDC), a California non-profit organization, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR," entered into a Professional Services Agreement which became effective on February 2, 2017 (the Agreement).

The parties now desire to amend certain provisions of the Professional Services Agreement to assist in the deliverables of the Native American Pilot Project, described by Grant Agreement 16-10150;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree to amend the following Sections and Exhibits as follows:

- 1. <u>DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES</u>: Exhibit A Scope of Services dated October 25, 2016 is hereby amended, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. In anticipation of a Seventy Six Thousand One Hundred Seventy Six Dollars (\$76,176) increase in funds, CONTRACTOR agrees to increase the number of key informant interviews and focus groups conducted from ten to fifteen (10-15) key informant interviews and two (2) focus groups to thirty to forty (30-40) key informant interviews and four (4) focus groups in order better research and understand the targeted community for future nutrition education project implementation.
- 4. <u>COMPENSATION</u>: Exhibit B Schedule of Rates dated October 25, 2016 is hereby amended, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. For the contractual term period of October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017, the maximum amount payable by COUNTY for services rendered by CONTRACTOR, is Ninety Four Thousand One Hundred Seventy Six Dollars (\$94,176).

Except as modified herein, the Professional Services Agreement executed on February 2, 2017 shall remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this first amendment and the original Professional Services Agreement, the provisions of this first amendment shall govern.

#### EXHIBIT A SCOPE OF SERVICES

Northern California Indian Development Council February 1, 2017 to September 30, 2017

The Northern California Indian Development Council will assist with the deliverables of the Nutrition Education and Obesity Prevention State Standard Agreement Amendment # 16-1050 (A01) in order to complete the Year One activities of the Native American Pilot Project.

#### 1. SERVICES:

**NEOP Objective 1:** By September 30, 2017, complete formative work with select members of the Native American Community and/or health professionals serving them, to identify potentially successful components of a culturally-competent health and/or physical activity promotion campaign targeting Native American community members.

To assist in this meeting this objective, NCIDC will provide the following services:

- 1.1: Prepare and present one hour overview of all fourteen (14) tribal entities in Humboldt County to Healthy Communities staff.
- 1.2: Provide technical assistance to support DHHS research of existing data on health indicators of Native American populations.
- 1.3: Review information compiled by DHHS of existing nutrition education, and physical activity resources, and promising PSE projects supporting the California Native American population. Assist DHHS in identifying gaps and summarizing promising practices within this community as needed.
- 1.4: Conduct focus groups/key informant interviews with Native American community members, leaders and/or health professionals serving them to identify opportunities to enhance nutrition education, physical activity promotion, and culturally feasible policy, systems and/or environmental change approaches. Include representation from the fourteen (14) tribal entities in Humboldt County.
- 1.5: Compile recommendations proposing target audience and areas of opportunity based on the focus group/key informant interview research.

**NEOP Objective 2:** By September 30, 2017, provide on-going updates and technical assistance to DHHS and CDPH.

To assist in this meeting this objective, NCIDC will provide the following services:

- 2.1: Participate in monthly meetings with CDPH and or DHHS to discuss programming. These may be in the form of teleconferences, webinars or in person local meetings.
- 2.2: Invoice on quarterly basis with final invoice to be provided no later than November of the following fiscal year.
- 2.3: Present project to NEOPB staff at year end via a formal in-person meeting in Eureka.
