<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The California Coastal Commission will be considering Coast Seafood's project request at their September 13, 2017 meeting, to continue its existing aquaculture operations in Arcata Bay while reducing the size of its 300 acre operation by 21 acres. The Board of Supervisors has been asked for a letter of support for Coast Seafood's proposed project.

Aquaculture is a valuable public trust use in Humboldt Bay and an important part of Humboldt County's economy. Well managed shellfish farming can co-exist with other important bay resources and uses while protecting and enhancing high water quality. Humboldt Bay is the largest producer of oysters in California and Humboldt County and its residents continue to support this sustainable industry.

The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors would like to offer our support for Coast Seafood's proposed project in Arcata Bay to continue its existing aquaculture operations while reducing the size of its 300 acre operations by roughly 21 acres.

We believe that the current proposed project addresses many of the concerns raised during the June 7, 2017 Coastal Commission meeting by consolidating oyster farming operations and by implementing appropriate mitigation measures as recommended by Coastal Commission staff to address negative impacts going forward.
