<u>DISCUSSION:</u> Old markings at Murray Airport on Runway must be appropriately removed, in accordance with guidance listed in AC 150/5340-1L, *Standards for Airport Markings* in order to be in compliance with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the Caltrans Division of Aeronautics. The Road Division performed the required work with the purchase of supplies being made by Aviation. Contracting these services is excessively costly and difficult for the Aviation Division due to cost. If the Aviation Division does not restripe the old markings in accordance with guidance listed in AC 150/5340-1L, *Standards for Airport Markings* there is a risk of permit suspension causing Murray Airport to be closed until the work is complete.
