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

The project is to install centerline and edge-line traffic stripes using enhanced wet/night high visibility thermo-plastic markings incorporated with optical elements to increase retroreflectivity at night and during rain storms. This project is being funded under the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). Bidders are ad-vised that the work must be completed within 30 work-ing days. The Engineer's Estimate for this work is: \$227,700.

The successful Bidder shall furnish a Payment Bond and a Performance Bond.

The Contractor shall possess a CLASS "A" Contractors License at the time this contract is awarded.

No pre-bid meeting is scheduled for this project.

This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimina-tion and compliance requirements pursuant to Govern-ment Code, Section 12990. The County of Humboldt af-firms that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, as defined in 49 CFR Part 26, will be afforded full opportuni-ty to submit bids in response to this invitation.

For this contract, the County has included a Disadvan-taged Business Enterprises (DBE) goal of **1.0** Percent. Bidders need not achieve the percentage stated as a condition of award.

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambigui-ty of the plans, specifications or estimate must be com-municated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Any such inquiries or questions, submitted after bid opening, will not be treated as a bid protest.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates in the county, or counties, in which the work is to be done have been determined by the pirector of the California Department of Industrial

Relations.
