POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE (For publication after adoption)

On September 19, 2017, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. ____, which amends Ordinance No. 2555. Ordinance 2555 amended the Local Coastal Program - Coastal Zoning Regulations to expand the uses allowed in the Industrial/Coastal-Dependent (MC) zone district by providing for certain conditionally permitted noncoastal-dependent interim uses in the MC district on a temporary short-term basis, subject to performance standards designed to protect and prioritize coastal-dependent industrial (CDI) uses. Ordinance No. ____ makes clarifying edits and modifications to further prioritize coastal-dependent industrial uses over interim uses. The purpose of the Interim Use Local Coastal Program Amendment is to increase the potential for the use of vacant and underutilized MC zoned land around Humboldt Bay while at the same time protecting current and future long term CDI uses. The Amendment will become effective immediately upon certification by the California Coastal Commission. The names of the Supervisors voting for and against are as follows:
