- 2. Dis-allocate a 1.0 FTE Public Information Specialist (class 0195, salary range 419, unit 09) from the Sheriff's Office.

In the Fiscal Year 2017-18 adopted budget, your Board allocated a Public Information Specialist (class 0195) to the Sheriff's Office. However, the duties of the position in that class specified that the position
